In 1974, just after the foundation for piecing had been laid down, Part One entered the subway graffiti movement. He began doing the bubble and mechanical styles of the era, and, by 1976, had truly come into his own. From 1977 to 1980, few writers could compete

with Part One and his TDS partners. Today, Part One continues to burn and is considered a style master. This is the first book to deal exclusively with his impact on writing culture, with stories from the early days to the present. *Stage of Higher Knowledge* Tredition Classics
Classic graffiti lettering and experimental typographical forms lie at the heart of street culture and have long inspired designers in many different fields. But graffiti artists, who tend to

paint the same letters of their tag again and again, rarely design complete alphabets. Claudia Walde has spent over two years collecting alphabets by 154 artists from 30 countries with a view to showing the many different styles and approaches to lettering within the graffiti and street art cultures. All of the artists have roots in graffiti. Some are world renowned such as 123 Klan (Canada), Faith47 (South Africa) and Hera (Germany); others are lesser known or only now starting to emerge. Each artist received the same brief: to design all 26 letters of the Latin alphabet within the limits of a single page of the book. How they approached this task and selected the media with which to express their ideas was entirely up to them. The results are a fascinating insight into the

creative process.

This is a nostalgic, visual account of the best time and place to be a graffiti writer. In the 1980s, brothers Kenny, a.k.a. KEY, and Paul, a.k.a. CAVS, immersed themselves in the graffiti scene in the Boogie Down Bronx, dutifully photographing hundreds of pieces on now-discontinued MTA subway cars and capturing their proud comrades before, during, and after the act.

"Bombing" "White Elephants" with their pilot markers and documenting them with their cameras, which they always carried, they were on the ride of their lives--until 1989, when the last painted train was removed from service. Tags by names like QUIK, IZTHEWIZ, and many others appear here in color exposures, and dozens of artists share stories and drop knowledge with no filter. A foreword by graffiti historian Henry Chalfant, coproducer of Style Wars--the seminal documentary on New York graffiti and hip-hop culture--kicks things off.

Thomas Demands work lures the viewer into a reality that is not what it appears to be. His images present scenes of

political and social events, which the artist recreates out of paper and cardboard, in a scale that is true to the original size of the setting. Demand then photographs these sculptures, creating images in which specific traces of the events and the protagonists are removed, leaving possible evidence of a crime scene, one which appears familiar but yet out of reach. The exhibition and book Nationalgalerie brings together Demands work of the last 15 years which is rooted in German imagery. Demand examines the Deutschlandbild, the German image in photographs from a variety of scenarios in the post-war period. From a selection both known and new of key images of decisive political events and private moments Demand offers a kaleidoscopic vision of a society.

Henry More (12 October 1614 - 1

September 1687) was an English philosopher of the Cambridge Platonist school. He was a prolific writer of verse and prose. The Divine Dialogues (1688),

a treatise which condenses his general view of philosophy and religion. Like many others he began as a poet and ended as a prose writer. His first work, published in 1642, but written two years earlier, was entitled *Psychodoia Platonica: or, a Platonick Song of the Soul*, consisting of four several Poems. This was followed in 1647 by his full collection of *Philosophicall Poems*, which includes *The Song of the Soul*, 'much enlarged, and is dedicated 'to his dear father.' A second edition was published in the same year, and it was included by A. B. Grosart in his *Chertsey Worthies Library* (1878)."
